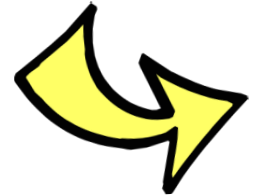

### Items Not Accepted at the Cleanup Event

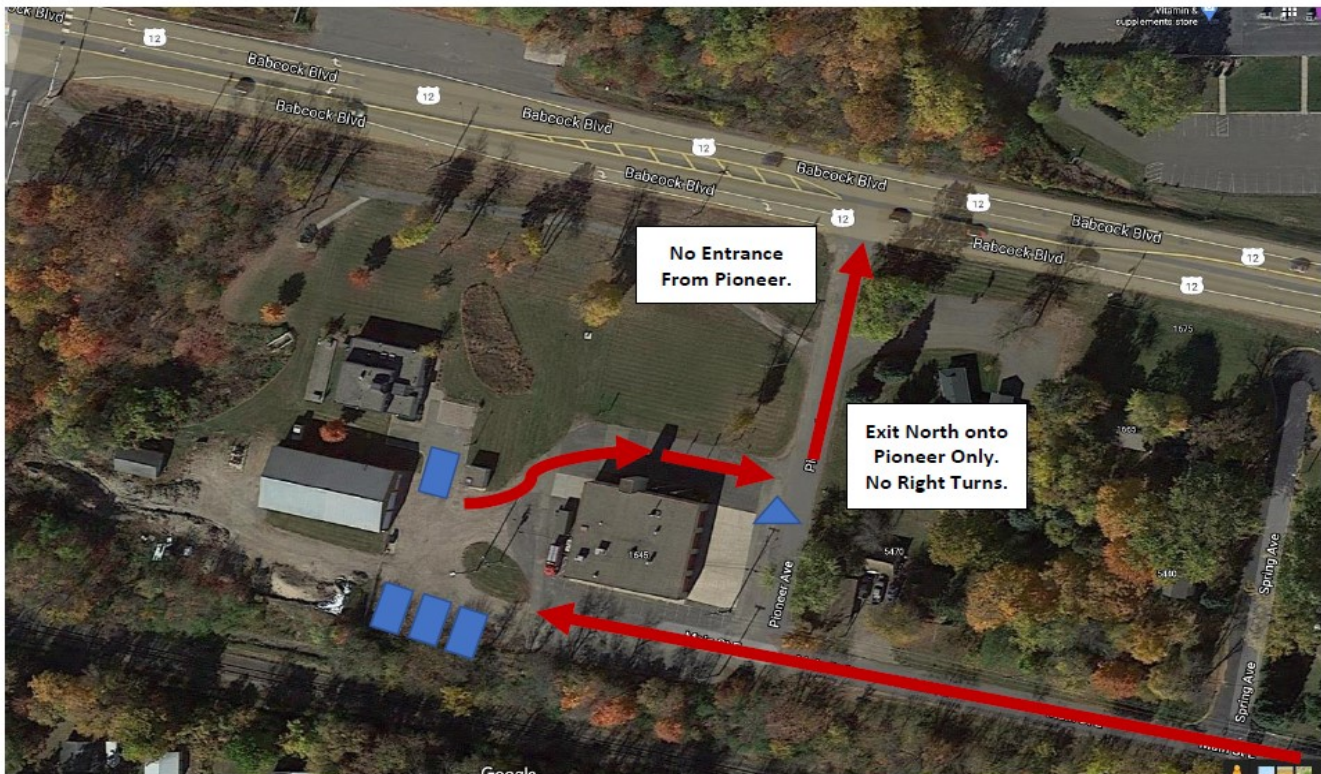
