Here's the weekly construction update for September 28th:

#### **Howard Avenue and Independence Street:**

Construction crews will be working on Saturday, September 29th. They anticipate working from 7 am to 3:30 pm. They will be working on storm sewer at the intersection of Howard and Independence so please note this intersection may not be accessible.

#### Week of October 1st Schedule-

The construction crew will continue to connect residential sewer and water lines to the city mains on Howard Ave for most of the week.
